	Wild Asia (WA) is a Malaysian-registered company (Reg. No: 634446-W) that operates as a social enterprise—an organization driven by social or environmental missions rather than the pursuit of profit or shareholder returns. In essence, WA functions as a not-for-profit entity, generating income primarily through consultancy, training, and related services.
Brief information about Applicant	To support oil palm producers in the palm oil sector, WA established the Wild Asia Group Scheme (WAGS). This initiative was created to address the unique challenges faced by small producers, helping them to adopt better agricultural practices and align with international standards such as the RSPO. WAGS is a community development programme designed to improve farmers' livelihoods through higher yields, reduced environmental and social risks, and improved access to sustainable palm oil markets.
	WAGS collaborates with supply chain stakeholders, international donors, and national organizations to build local support teams that guide and certify oil

palm producer groups. Launched in 2012, WAGS is active in Malaysia and Thailand and currently supports 3,328 small producers, producing a total of 402,350 mt of fresh fruit bunches (FFB) (out of which 211,604 mt are RSPOcertified).
