**3.0 Next steps**

The Secretariat informed the JWG that the 17th General Assembly will take place on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2020 and there will be no submission of Resolutions allowed. Working Groups, however, are allowed to make appeals to the BoG to submit a resolution.

Following the standard practice, upon endorsement of the CSD at the JWG level, the CSD will need to be endorsed by the SSC and BoG before it is tabled for endorsement at the General Assembly.

The Secretariat will connect the co-chairs of the JWG and SSC for the endorsement process of the CSD at the SSC level. The JWG aims to table the CSD to the BoG on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2020. Appeals for resolution submission will be made once the CSD has been approved by the BoG.
