Supra Matra Abadi – Teluk Panjie Mill, and Supply Bases consist of 1 (one) with RSPO ID PalmTrace number: RSPO\_PO1000002146.

The Recertification Assessment scope is PT Supra Matra Abadi – Teluk Panjie Mill and 1 (one) own Estate as supply base located at Teluk Panjie Village, Kampung Rakyat District, Labuhanbatu Selatan Regency, Sumatera Utara Province, Indonesia against the requirement of RSPO P&C 2018 / National Interpretations for Indonesia, in conjunction with RSPO Certification System 2020 (November 2020).
