Company background

Chumporn Palm Oil Industry Public Company Limited (CPI mill, CPP mill, and its supply bases) has been a member of RSPO since 16 June 2009 with membership number 1-0234-17-000-00. The Certification Unit (CU) is located at 296 Moo 2, Salui Sub-District, Thasae District, Chumporn Province which consists of 5 directly Managed Estates. The total combined land area of the CU is 3,360.80 Ha of which; 3,202.51 Ha had been planted with oil palm.

Chumporn Palm Oil Industry Public Company Limited (CPI) was established in 1979. CPI began the business as an oil palm grower with their own oil palm plantations covering an area of over 3,200 hectares. CPI has maintained a generous supply of fresh fruit bunch by operating their own oil palm plantations through their own palm oil mill (POM) which is processed by using advanced machinery from De Smet (Belgium), in order to ensure that only the best quality products comply with international standards. The capacity of CPI mill is 60 MT/hour. CPI expanded their business by increasing our registered capital in 1993 to extend production capacity and build a refinery plant to become the first integrated organization in the palm oil business in Thailand. Thereby, CPI then transformed into a public company, listed in the Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) henceforth. CPI has served society with various kinds of quality products. Their customers range from downstream industries to cooking oil consumer market. CPI has CPP company limited is the subsidiary. CPP is a palm oil mill with capacity 45 MT/hour, established in Bangsapannoi district, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, Thailand

The company have a commitment to certify RSPO P&C in 2025 and have a RSPO member since **16 June 2009**.

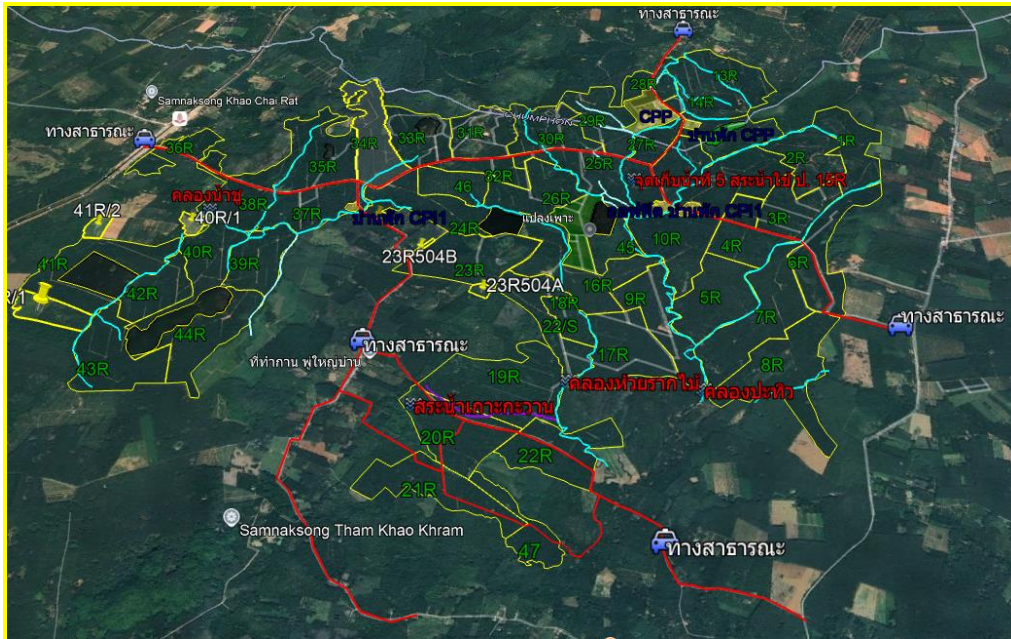


Figure 1: CPI 1 Estate

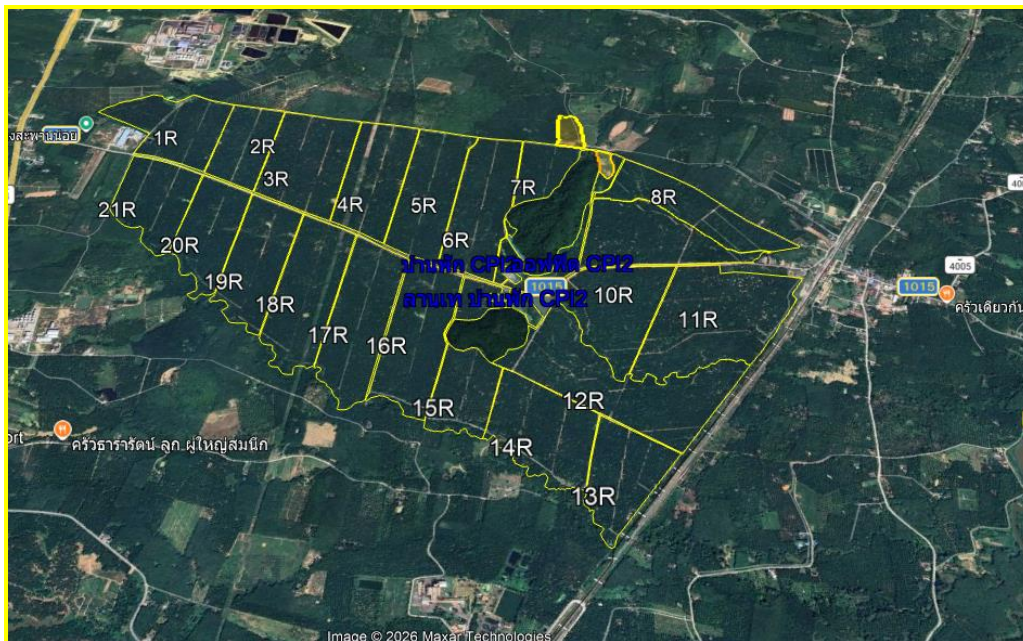


Figure 2: CPI 2 Estate

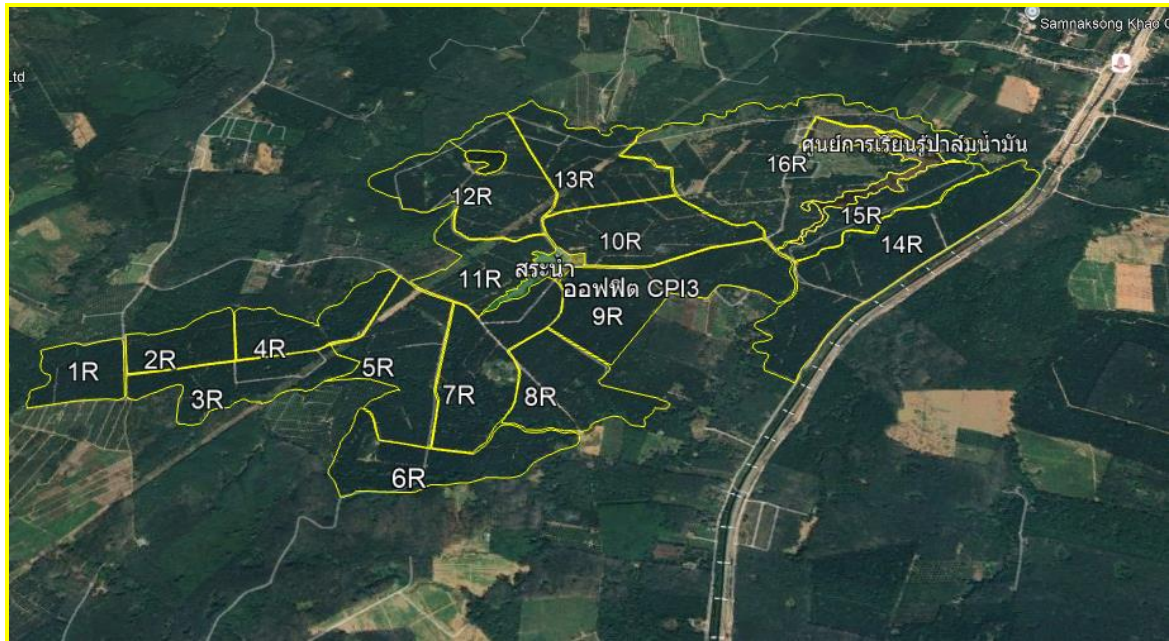


Figure 3: CPI 3 Estate

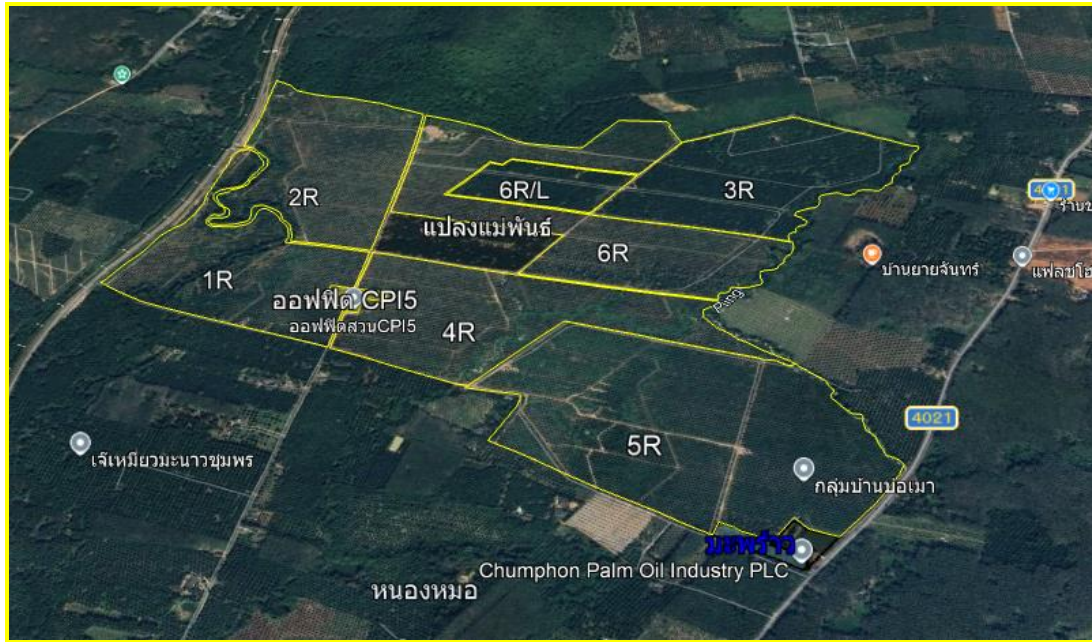


Figure 5: CPI 5 Estate
