Notification of RSPO Re-Certification Assessment of Extractora Sicarare SAS, Colombia RSPO Membership: 2-0637-16-000-00

To Whom It May Concern:

Extractora Sicarare SAS of Colombia has commissioned SCS Global Services to conduct an RSPO Re-Certification Assessment of its palm oil mill and supply basin located near KM 11 AL SUR DE CODAZZI, AGUSTIN CODAZZI, DEPARTAMENTO DEL CESAR, 202050, Colombia. The assessment will be conducted of 1 Palm Oil Mill and 1 Oil Palm Plantations, 2 Outgrowers, 0 Scheme Smallholders.

SCS Global Services plans to conduct the Re-Certification assessment of the Extractora Sicarare SAS mill from **September 2 – 6, 2024**. The assessment will be conducted against the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil requirements, including the Principles & Criteria (RSPO P&C 2018 including Supply Chain requirement for mills), using as reference the National Interpretation of the P&Cs for the **Colombia/2020**).

The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, and social aspects as required by the RSPO Principles & Criteria. Below is general information related to the certification unit.
