



Notification of RSPO Re-Certification Assessment of Sungai Binti Palm Oil Mill – PT AGRO BUKIT, Indonesia RSPO Membership: 1-0175-14-000-00

To Whom It May Concern:

Sungai Binti Palm Oil Mill – PT AGRO BUKIT a subsidiary of Goodhope Asia Holdings Ltd has commissioned SCS Global Services to conduct an RSPO Re-Certification Assessment of its palm plantation and supply bases located at Natai Baru Village, Mentaya Hilir Utara Sub District, Kotawaringin Timur District; Kalimantan Tengah Province, Indonesia. The assessment will be conducted on 1 Oil Mill and 4 Nucleus Palm Plantations and 4 Scheme smallholders.

SCS Global Services plan to conduct the Re-Certification assessment of Sungai Binti Palm Oil Mill – PT AGRO BUKIT from 13th to 17th October 2025. The assessment will be conducted against the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil requirements, including the Principles & Criteria (RSPO P&C 2018 including Supply Chain requirement for mills), using as reference the National Interpretation of the P&C for Indonesia/2021).

The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, and social aspects as required by the RSPO Principles & Criteria. Below is general information related to the certification unit.
